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Guidelines for Team Sheet Fees

Weekly fees are charged to parents for the main purpose of covering the cost of the team sheet fee each week (varies from \$27.00 to \$37.00 dollars depending on age group). For current game fee rates you can check at the pay window of the venue where they display all the relevant charges, or a guide to team sheet fees can be found on the Kilsyth Basketball website (it is under MENU then COMPETITIONS and then GAME FEES <http://www.kilsythbasketball.com.au/game-fees/>)

As a general rule, for most teams, \$5 per week is the normal amount that would be charged. This should be collected each week and not in a lump sum, however some people may like to pay several weeks in advance. We do not expect team managers to be responsible for safeguarding large amounts of the team's money.

If varying this amount, it is very important to consult with parents first to reach a consensus about team sheet fees - don't just decide yourself.

It is acceptable to charge double the amount on the first couple of weeks so as to have enough funds ready each week in the early stage of the season. If you charge \$10 per week for the first 2 weeks it gets you enough in the kitty to drop back to \$5 without having to ask for the awkward amount of \$7 each week. If you have less than 8 regular players and you run short again through the season you can ask for another one off \$10 payment.

If someone fills in for the team on a one off basis to cover a player shortage, it is considerate not to ask/charge them the weekly fee, as they are doing your team a favour. However if it becomes a permanent 'thing' that they fill in it would be reasonable to ask them to pay.

If you accumulate a float of more than \$60 mid-season at the end of a game day, you may consider offering a 'free week' to parents. Alternatively, it should be explained to the parents that any left over money at the end of the season will be used to purchase a present for the coach and to help pay for a break up function for the team (leaving no money in the float).

Records need to be kept and made available to the Age Co-ordinator when requested.
