

Hi Team Managers,

I hope your teams are all having a successful and fun season.

As we are now well into the fixture we need to be thinking finals and making sure all our players qualify.

For players to be eligible to play in finals they need to have played in at least half the games which the team has played in the season.

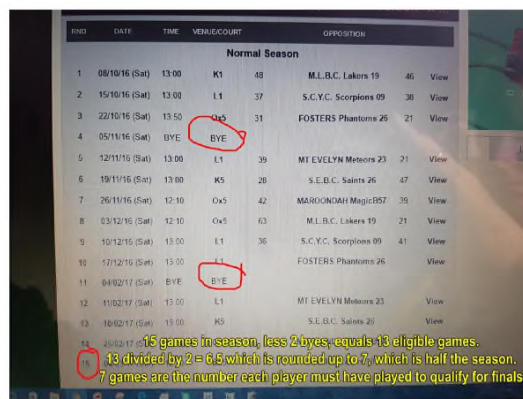
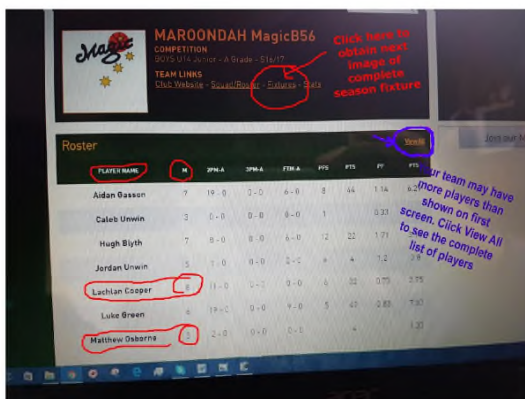
To figure this out for each player you need to look up your team on the Kilsyth Mountain District Basketball Association (KMDBA) website.

Once located you need to calculate how many games the team will play, and then check how many games each player has played.

To do this, deduct the number of season byes the team has, from the number of games in the season. Then halve that number to get the number of games needed to be eligible to play in finals. For example, 15 games less 2 byes = 13, divided by 2 = 6.5, which is then rounded up to 7.

Images are attached to explain this.



In the above example you will see Lachlan has qualified already with more than 7 games, but Matthew needs to play another 4 before the end of round 15 to be eligible.

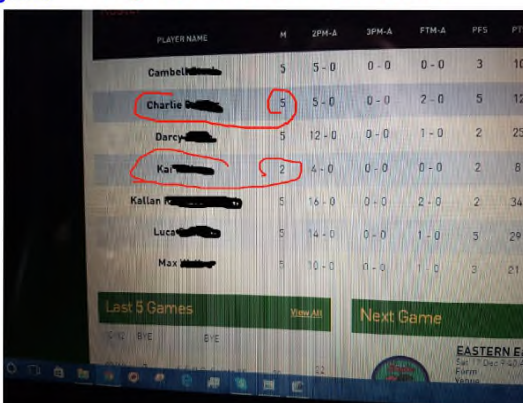
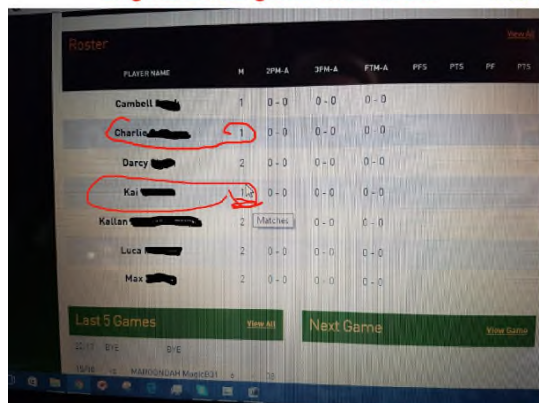
To see all players in the team you need to click on the 'View All' tab, as normally only 7 players are shown on the first screen.

If your team was re-graded after the first few rounds, you will need to look them up in each grade to calculate the number of games played, as their current fixture will only show games played in the current grade. If this information is not available, contact your Age Co-Ordinator, who can check with Kilsyth Administration.
